### *Event Details:*

Prof. Adil Najam talks about the opportunities and challenges facing Pakistan, a country of more than 150 million people, located at the crossroads to the Middle East, Asia Pacific and Central Asia. With a heritage as old as human civilization, Pakistan is emerging as a major economic player in the region. Adil lays out the challenges faced by Pakistan and Pakistanis as they come to terms with globalization.

### **Professor Adil Najam**

Before joining the faculty of Tufts University, Adil Najam served as an Assistant Professor of International Relations at Boston University. He has also taught at the MIT and the University of Massachusetts at Boston. He was the Winner of the MIT Goodwin Medal for Effective Teaching in 1997. He is a Director, Board of Governors at the Pakistan Institute for Environment-Development Action Research (PIEDAR) and the Pakistan Center for Trade and Sustainable Development (PCTSD). His research interests include international multilateral negotiation, sustainable development, human development and human security. Adil has a BSc from the University of Engineering and Technology, Lahore, Pakistan; MS in Civil and Environmental Engineering; MS in Technology and Policy; and, PhD in International Environmental Policy, Massachusetts Institute of Technology.
