### PROGRAM TIMELINE

**Program Kick Off:** A Friday and half-day Saturday commitment in mid-January

Monthly Sessions: Once-a-month full-day sessions from 9 a.m. - 5 p.m. CT on Fridays from February through June

Closing Retreat: One weekend in late September in New York City

#### WHO SHOULD APPLY?

Nonprofit organizations that meet the following criteria are eligible to apply:

- Annual Operating Budget of \$500K+
- Established leadership team
- Predominantly serve the Black community in Chicago

Applications open in mid-September and close in mid-October every year.
